It's Advent Time! The four weeks leading up to Christmas, and by it's nature, it is a season of endings and beginnings. As one year ends, a new church year begins though the world spins madly on. And in all that spinning, as we navigate seasons filled with endings and beginnings, what our hearts and souls need most are reminders. Words that feel like steady ground, like a familiar path to our feet, that can guide us forward into the unknown.

Our theme this Advent season is "Words For The Beginning" and through it we hope to make space for God to give you the words you need to hear again and again at the end and beginning of EVERY new season throughout the year.

Two stories helped form our vision for Advent this year. The first is from the artist, Hannah Garrity. "For years I have whispered into my child's ear. Words, affirmations, anchoring concepts of a life well lived along side God. And my children have been molded, as I was by my mother, by the goodness and love of God reflected in them. Though sometimes it feels like speaking a pipe dream into existence. Like, when my boy ran behind and have a Tom and Jerry style whacked to the head of my little girl. I wrapped him up and whispered my dreams of goodness into his ear again. I also took away TV for a few years, but it was those words that he held onto and is living into now. The same ones my mother said to me and that God sends to all of us. The second is from Rev. Sarah Speed. My dad had his "4 truths" that he wanted us to memorize. They were 4 reminders about love, responsibility, choices and God's care for us. Any time we left the house as teens, he would just hold up 4 fingers and we knew what he meant. It was love and a guide until we came home again.

Reading Jesus' story, we imagine the words Mary spoke to her young son to form and guide him? Like handlebars of wisdom, it is these simple words that help us hold onto God as God holds onto us through the bull ride of life. And so, our weekly themes may feel like the kind we teach to children, but in reality, they are the lessons we continue to learn as adults. Digging deeper that endless well of God's love and wisdom for us.

What does this mean for worship? Throughout Advent, cards with different words on them will be hanging throughout the church. Each Sunday, as part of worship, you will be invited to listen to the scriptures, hear stories of how God is using it to give "a word" to others in the congregation, and then reflect on what word God might be inviting you to "hold onto" also by looking through and choosing a "word cards" for yourself.

By the end of Advent, we hope everyone will have 4 words to return to and reflect on throughout the year. And we want to return to them with you in other seasons.


















## January "New Year" Offering Care & Share Monthly Meals


